BCSE Workshop Description:

During the **PIN workshop**, a 3-hr virtual event, participants will work together with ECFVG's test developers from Prometric to review problem identified questions. The objective for the PIN workshop is for you to evaluate pre-test items with data as to how they are performing.

During the **item review workshop**, a three-day event at the AVMA headquarter in Schaumburg, Illinois, participants will work together with ECFVG's test developers from Prometric to review questions developed by other subject matter experts. The objective of the three-day workshop is to ensure that all questions considered for an exam form are appropriate for the BSCE. During the **form review workshop**, a three-day virtual event, participants will help ECFVG's test developers from Prometric® get a clear, bird's eye view of the appropriateness of the selected questions and their placement on the forms. Please remember, all items on forms have already been reviewed/approved/used on prior forms, so the focus is not on wordsmithing items, but to focus on any major issues with items (e.g., out of date, no longer relevant, content overlap, cueing).
