Rabies in Canada

The CVMA has developed a new article with key messages about rabies awareness to share with clients and the public. Canadians sometimes think of Rabies as a "disease of the past." Globally, however, it still kills almost 60,000 people per year. Rabies is almost always fatal; in all of history less than 20 people are reported to have survived a clinical rabies infection. Rabies affects the central nervous system of humans and other mammals. It is transmitted through the bite of an infected animal, or if saliva, blood, or other fluids from

an infected animal directly enter the eyes, nose, mouth, or an open wound. Read the entire article here.
